São Tomé and Príncipe Economic Outlook Real GDP growth rose slightly from 0.1% in 2022 to an estimated 0.5% in 2023. The slow growth was due mainly to the prolonged impact of power



disruptions on the economy, aggravated by Russia"s invasion of Ukraine, which led to higher food and oil prices in global markets. Inflation rose sharply, from 8.1% in 2021 to 17.9% at the end ...
