The country is building the Boundiali Solar Power Station, which will have a capacity of 37.5 megawatt-peak (MWp).

The floating power plant intended to ease Ivory Coast's energy crisis before phase one of the Baleine project launches in 2023 is stuck in the starting blocks. Arriving in Abidjan in February, the Turkish group Karpowership has still not commissioned its 224-megawatt floating power plant.
