

What is EDF doing to support Ivory Coast's energy transition?

Renewable energy and... As part of its active involvement in supporting Ivory Coast's commitment to the energy transition, EDF is developing an innovative biomass power plant project in partnership with local energy players. Ivory Coast is aiming for an energy mix in which 42% will come from renewable energy by 2030.

Why did Côte d'Ivoire privatize its electricity sector?

Côte d'Ivoire's decision to privatize a portion of its electricity sector paved the way for one of the continent's most robust energy systems that continues to expand and innovate with clean energy solutions. This feat would not have been possible without private sector involvement and complex financial packages.

Who owns electricity in Côte d'Ivoire?

Electricity is sold to consumers by the Ivorian Electricity Company (CIE), in application of the concession agreement established with the government of Côte d'Ivoire in 1990 (Decree No. 90-1389 of 25 October 1990) and renewed in 2005 (Decree No. 2005-520 of October 27, 2005) for 15 years, has exclusive rights to transmit and sell electricity.

Does Côte d'Ivoire have a power grid?

The grid is expected to cover 99% of the population by 2035, and 42% of the energy produced will come from renewable sources. That is reassuring news for Côte d'Ivoire. In the wake of the post-electoral crisis of 2011, only 34% of the population had access to electricity. Today, close to 94% of Ivorians are connected to the power grid.

Why did EDF sign a concession contract with the Ivorian government?

To help it achieve this goal, EDF signed a concession contract with the Ivorian government in December 2019 via BIOVEA Energie (owned with its partners Meridiam and Biokala, a subsidiary of the SIFCA group). This contract involves the design, financing, construction and operation of a 46 MW biomass power plant over 25 years.

Ivory Coast aims to increase its installed power capacity to 3.5 GW by 2025 and 8.6 GW by 2040. As part of this strategy, the country's Ministry of Mines, Petroleum and Energy signed a memorandum of understanding ...
