



How much solar power does Ivory Coast have?

Coulibaly said the Ivory Coast's installed solar capacity currently stands at 2,907 MW. The country is now working toward deployment targets of 3,500 MW in 2025,5,200 MW by 2030 and 8,600 by 2040. Ivory Coast's first solar power plant, located in the northern town of Boundiali, was commissioned in 2022.

When will Ivory Coast's solar power plants be built?

The minister said that contracts are currently under review for the construction of other solar power plants, with a cumulative capacity of 600 MW. Commissioning of these projects will take place in 2025 and 2026. Coulibaly said the Ivory Coast's installed solar capacity currently stands at 2,907 MW.

How many solar power plants will Ivory Coast have by 2030?

He said Ivory Coast will have added 678 MWfrom solar power plants projects to its power network by 2030. The state-owned Boundiali Solar Power Plant,located about 660 km (410 miles) north of the commercial capital Abidjan,became operational in June 2023. Authorities hope to extend its capacity to 83 MW from its current 37.5 MW by April 2025.

Will Ivory Coast become a major power supplier in West Africa?

BOUNDIALI, Ivory Coast, April 3 (Reuters) - Ivory Coast officially opened a 37.5 megawatt (MW) solar power plant on Wednesday in what the government said was the first step of a plan to integrate more renewable energy into the power sector. Ivory Coast, the world's top cocoa producer, is seeking to become a major power supplier in West Africa.

Who financed the Ivory Coast solar power station?

The 75.6-million-euro (\$82.1-million) cost of building the solar power station was financed by Ivory Coast, a German loan and a European Union grant. "This is the result of the EU's long-standing commitment to the renewable energy sector,with almost 140 million euros since 2017," EU ambassador to Ivory Coast Francesca Di Mauro told AFP.

Where does Ivorian energy come from?

Solar power is currently a small part of the Ivorian energy mix -- the Boundiali plant contributes just one percent of national production. Nearly 70 percent of the country's electricity comes from gas-fired thermal power plants, while hydroelectric power stations account for the rest, all located in the south.

The last census in Ivory Coast took place in 1998 and found a population of 15.37 million, up from the 6.7 million people in the country at the first census in 1975. Today, Ivory Coast has a population density of 64 people per square kilometer (166/square mile), which ranks 139th in the world. Largest Cities in Ivory Coast
