Does Mozambique need solar energy?

In the rapidly evolving world of renewable energy, Mozambique has emerged as a significant player, especially in the solar energy sector. With its abundant sunshine and increasing focus on sustainable development, the demand for solar energy systems in Mozambique has seen a considerable rise.

Is Mozambique a good place to invest in solar energy?

Mozambique has an abundant and unexploited solar resource which could be harnessed for utility scale as well as residential PV for both on/off grid electrification. The following map shows the global horizontal irradiation profile of Mozambique which varies between 1,785 and 2,206 kWh/m²/year.

Who built Mozambique's first large-scale solar power plant?

Capital and expertise from Scatec Solar, KLP and Norfund enabled the construction of Mozambique's first large-scale solar power plant. Central Solar de Mocuba (CESOM) provides over 79 GWh of electricity annually, which is equivalent to the electricity consumption of more than 170,000 households in Mozambique.

Which zone has the highest solar power potential in Mozambique?

The zones marked in the darkest shade show the highest potential. By the end of 2022, there is a total of 125 MW of solar power plants (under a public-private partnership (PPP)) developed in Mozambique, of which 60 MW are already connected to the national grid: Projects Mocuba and Metoro.

Where is Mozambique's power plant located?

The plant was built in the Zambezia Province in north-central Mozambique. Mozambique is one of the poorest countries in the world and access to electricity is extremely limited. In rural areas only 6 percent of the population has an electricity supply. National demand for electricity is growing significantly due to industrial and commercial growth.

How can private-public partnerships support economic growth in Mozambique?

Transmission bottlenecks mean that decentralised power plants based on local energy resources such as solar, hydro can be important in supplying remote regions. This is an excellent example of how private-public partnerships can deliver renewable energy and support further economic growth in Mozambique.
