

What is the climate like in New Caledonia?

The climate in New Caledonia is tropical, influenced by the trade winds, with a hot and rainy season from late December to late March, a cool and drier season from June to August or September, and two intermediate periods. New Caledonia is an archipelago located in the Pacific Ocean to the south of the Equator.

What is New Caledonia's energy policy?

As a country of Oceania, one of the parts of the world most impacted by climate change, New Caledonia wishes to be exemplary in terms of energy policy. Building on the Paris Agreement, the Congress of New Caledonia adopted the Energetic Transition Scheme of New Caledonia (STENC) in June 2016. The scheme has three main objectives for 2030:

How much rain does New Caledonia get?

On the southern coast, in contrast, rainfall ranges from 800 to 1,200 mm (31 to 47 in), therefore, some areas are almost arid. However, in New Caledonia, the rains are quite irregular from one year to another, so they are quite unpredictable.

What is the weather like in New Caledonia during El Nio?

During El Niño years, the weather in New Caledonia tends to be drier than normal from December to February and drier and cooler than normal from June to August. On the other hand, during La Niña years, it becomes rainier than usual from December to February and warmer than usual from June to August.
