Saint-Pierre and Miquelon are a small group of islands in the North Atlantic Ocean, located at the mouth of the Gulf of Saint Lawrence, at 19 kilometres from Newfoundland. First settled by the French in the early 17th century, the islands represent the sole remaining vestige of France's once vast North American empire, New France.

What does Saint-Pierre and Miquelon have in common?

As a part of France, the area has much in common with Europe, but also with its Canadian and American neighbours. Although Saint-Pierre and Miquelon are territories of France, and as such are within the European Union, they are not part of the Schengen Area and so immigration procedures are different from those of France.

All power sockets in Saint Pierre and Miquelon provide a standard voltage of 230V with a standard frequency of 50Hz. This is the case in most of Europe, Australia, the United Kingdom and most countries in Africa and Asia. ...
