

Are Saint-Pierre & Miquelon a country?

The islands are a well-known separate country-level entity among many radio amateurs, identifiable with ITU prefix "FP". Those visiting, mainly from the US, activate Saint-Pierre and Miquelon every year on amateur frequencies.

The department of Saint-Pierre and Miquelon is served by three television stations: Saint-Pierre-et-Miquelon 1ère (call sign FQN) on Channel 8, with a repeater on Channel 31, and France 212; on Channel 6.

Does Saint-Pierre and Miquelon have a health care system?

Saint-Pierre and Miquelon's health care system is entirely public and free. In 1994, France and Canada signed an agreement allowing the residents of the archipelago to be treated in St. John's.

Does Saint Pierre and Miquelon have a football team?

Saint Pierre and Miquelon has a domestic football league comprising three teams. Starting in 2018, local clubs have competed in France's domestic knockout cup, the Coupe de France. How did Saint-Pierre and Miquelon become a territory?

After the 1958 French constitutional referendum, the territory of Saint-Pierre and Miquelon was asked to choose one of three options: becoming fully integrated with France, becoming a self-governing state within the French Community, or preserving the status of an overseas territory; it decided to remain a territory.

Three of the stations are on Saint-Pierre, two of which are owned by Outre-Mer 1ère, along with one 1ère station on Miquelon. At night, these stations broadcast France-Inter.

Air Saint-Pierre operates direct Saint Pierre and Miquelon flights to Paris, France, in the summer months. You can also catch the ferry from Fortune, Newfoundland, which takes about 1.5 hours. The ferry runs three times a week, and tickets can be booked in advance or purchased on the morning of departure at the terminal.

Saint-Pierre was a site for settlement by the French in the early 17th century, later abandoned under the Treaty of Utrecht, and returned to France in 1763 at the end of the Seven Years War. As well, the islands became a place of refuge for Acadian deportees from Nova Scotia. Saint-Pierre figures frequently in North American British-French relations.

A ten-minute boat ride away, l'le aux Marins is an excursion not to be missed. This small island is a witness to the history of fishing in Saint-Pierre-et-Miquelon. Since the 19th century, the village of Miquelon has been the center of the archipelago's agricultural activities, with farming and livestock, but also a mecca for coastal fishing.
