

Where is Sao Tome and Principe located?

Officially named Democratic Republic of Sao Tomé and Principe,or just Sao Tomé for short,this archipelago is located in Gulf of Guineaapproximately 180 miles off the West African coast,adjacent to Nigeria. It is made up of two major volcanic islands surrounded by eight small islets, of which 6 are inhabited.

The concession project also includes the modernization of the current ports in Sao Tome and Principe. In March 2021,a \$1.3 billion concession project for the construction of a free trade zone in the south of Sao Tome was signed between the government and a Canadian investor.

In 2019,the World Bank approved \$29 million to finance the repair of 27 kilometers of the main road linking São Tomé city and Neves on the northern coast of the island.

Does Sao Tome and Principe have a right to education?

The Human Rights Measurement Initiative (HRMI) finds that Sao Tome and Principe is fulfilling only 83.8% of its expected commitments to the right to educationbased on the country's level of income. HRMI breaks down the right to education by looking at the rights to both primary education and secondary education.
