Once built, the solar plant will extend its supply power from the Vatican radio station to the entire 825 people living in the city. The city only produced about 0.0000443% output of carbon emission in 2022 but the Pope is eager to transition successfully to encourage the development of sustainable models in other countries.

In a suite of efforts, Pope Francis has now declared to the Vatican authorities to carry out the next step: to begin constructing a solar plant within the extraterritorial zone of ...

Vatican Solar Path. Building solar plants is a part of the Vatican''s historical plan to go green. In 1971 Pope Paul VI in 1971 said that «humanity risked destroying nature by exploiting it». However, the first materialistic steps were made only in 2008, when 2,400 solar panels were installed on the roofs of the Vatican''s Paul V Hall.
