The Grenadines island of Mayreau will be home to the First Solar Battery Storage Microgrid System within the state. In December 2017 Vinlec and EcoEnergy, N.V. a Curacao solar energy firm, signed a contract to begin the engineering, procurement, and construction of the system.

There is a hybrid system used on the island to produce electricity. VINLEC uses diesel engines to generate electricity and there is also a solar photovoltaic (PV) and Battery Storage system which was installed in 2019. Electricity was introduced to St. Vincent and the Grenadines in 1931 by the then Crown Colony Government.

The EPC contract was signed in late December between St. Vincent and the Grenadines utility, VINLEC, and Curacao solar energy firm, EcoEnergy, N.V. for the utility's first solar battery storage microgrid. The system, to be built on the island of Mayreau in the Grenadines, will produce enough energy to power the island for 6 to 10 hours per day.

Saint Vincent and Grenadines receives high levels of solar irradiation (GHI) of 5.2 kWh/m²/day and specific yield 4.3 kWh/kWp/day indicating strong technical feasibility for solar in the country.³ In 2021, 26.67% of the country's power demand was met through renewable sources.⁴

Current Situation 2.1 Fuel imports and energy costs Saint Vincent and the Grenadines (SVG) has a population of 100,272 (2006 estimate)¹ inhabitants, with approximately 92,000 of those living on the main island, St. Vincent.

Keeping an AIMS Power inverter handy may be one of the most important aspects of living in St. Vincent and the Grenadines, because having an emergency backup power system is vital if living on the island.. St. Vincent and the Grenadines electricity is 230 Vac 50 Hz, but power outages are common due to extreme tropical weather and electrical systems that can be unreliable.

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
