

What is a Svalbard & Jan Mayen islands?

The United Nations Statistics Division also uses this code,but has named it the Svalbard and Jan Mayen Islands. Svalbard is an archipelago in the Arctic Oceanunder the sovereignty of Norway,but is subject to the special status granted by the Svalbard Treaty.

What do Svalbard and Jan Mayen have in common?

Svalbard and Jan Mayen have in common that they are the only integrated parts of Norway not allocated to counties. While a separate ISO code for Svalbard was proposed by the United Nations, it was the Norwegian authorities who took initiative to include Jan Mayen in the code. Its official language is Norwegian.

What country code is Svalbard & Jan Mayen?

Svalbard and Jan Mayen are collectively assigned the ISO 3166-1 alpha-2 country-code "SJ". Both areas are administered by Norway,though they are separated by a distance of over 950 kilometres (510 nautical miles) and have very different administrative structures.

What does Svalbard and Jan Mayen stand for?

Svalbard and Jan Mayen (Norwegian: Svalbard og Jan Mayen,ISO 3166-1 alpha-2: SJ,ISO 3166-1 alpha-3: SJM,ISO 3166-1 numeric: 744) is a statistical designation defined by ISO 3166-1 for a collective grouping of two remote jurisdictions of Norway: Svalbard and Jan Mayen.

Who owns the Svalbard archipelago?

The Norwegian statetook possession of all unclaimed land,or 95.2% of the archipelago,at the time the Svalbard Treaty entered into force; Store Norske,a Norwegian coal mining company,owns 4%,Arktikugol,a Russian coal mining company,owns 0.4%,while other private owners hold 0.4%.

Where is the Svalbard archipelago?

The Svalbard archipelago lies about 700 km north of Norwaybetween 74°N and 81°N and between 10°E and 35°E (Fig. 8.1.1.1).

MOSJ (Environmental Monitoring of Svalbard and Jan Mayen) is an environmental monitoring system and part of the Norwegian Government's environmental monitoring in Norway. The site provides historical climate records (ocean, land, and atmosphere), including temperature precipitation, snow, permafrost and sea-ice.

Politically, Jan Mayen is an integral part of Norway. The eighteen people living on the island work for either the NorwegianArmed Forces or the Norwegian Meteorological Institute. Their main purpose is to operate the Loran-C radio navigation system. From 1615 to 1638, the Dutch ran a whaling station here.
