

Timor-Leste back up energy

How many people benefited from a rural energy programme in Timor-Leste?

The programme reached 1,875 individuals in 375 households, with multiple impacts on quality of life, income and livelihoods. The programme also developed a national Rural Energy Policy, creating an overarching framework for future government activities in improving rural energy access in Timor-Leste.

Does predp paved the way for future energy access in Timor-Leste?

Conclusions Although PREDP was a pilot programme, it has paved the way for future energy access activities in Timor-Leste. It was the first rural energy programme in Timor-Leste to include a capacity development component, and to have the GoTL and local communities as major partners.

Will East Timor transition its energy sector?

Still, East Timor's government has expressed interest in transitioning its energy sector. In 2020, it hired energy consultants to conduct a feasibility study for supplying natural gas to the three power plants. In 2021, it announced tendering for solar parks and a feasibility study for hydropower schemes.

What impact did predp have on Timor-Leste?

Identified impacts included improved health, increased income, improved school results for children and reduced domestic violence. PREDP also supported the development of a national Rural Energy Policy, which will provide overarching guidance to planning, budgeting and implementation of rural energy programmes in Timor-Leste.

Is East Timor interested in solar power?

East Timor President Jos#233; Ramos-Horta told The Associated Press in an interview in Dili last week that his country is interested in exploring various types of renewable energy sources, including wind, sea and especially solar power. "We have plenty of sun," he said, adding that the cost of solar technology continues to fall.
