Who owns Senoko energy?

Japan's Marubeni and French utility Engie, the main shareholders of Singapore-based Senoko Energy, are considering the sale of their stakes, Bloomberg has reported. The two companies - each holding a 30% stake in the company - are valuing it at \$3bn.

What does Senoko energy do?

Senoko Energy is a Singaporean electric utility company and retailer. It is the largest power generation company in Singapore, accounting for approximately 20% of the nation's electricity supply. It also operates the Senoko Power Station, the nation's largest power plant by generation capacity.

Does Sembcorp own Senoko energy?

Sembcorp (SGX:U96) agreed to acquire ENGIE's 30% interest in Senoko Energy. Senoko has a fifth of its power generation capacity in Singapore and is a licensed gas shipper and retailer. Pricing details are not available and subject to regulatory approvals and pre-emption right of other shareholders of Senoko.

Where is Senoko energy located?

Senoko Energy has a 2.8GW combined cycle gas turbine (CCGT) plant at Woodlands in north Singapore, accounting for 21.7% of Singapore's installed power generation capacity and 15.4% of generated electricity as of 1H23. Comparatively, Sembcorp has ~10% generated electricity market share.

Who is Senoko energy Pte Ltd?

Since then, we have evolved to offer a balanced portfolio of natural gas, advanced energy solutions, tank leasing, terminal services and electricity supply. Senoko Energy Pte Ltd is owned by a consortium comprising Marubeni Corporation, ENGIE S.A.,

Where is Senoko Power Station located?

The company's power station is located in the northern part of the city-state. It has a licensed capacity of 2.64GW and meets 20% of Singapore's electricity demand. In 2008, Marubeni and Engie, as part of a consortium, acquired Senoko from Temasek for S\$3.65bn (\$2.7bn), which included taking on S\$323m of net debt.
