VATICAN CITY, Holy See (AFP) -- Pope Francis has ordered the Vatican to install a solar plant that will provide electricity to the entire city state, as the pontiff does his bit to tackle climate ...

The Vatican has been seeking to drastically reduce its environmental impact by adopting more renewable energy sources, pursuing a goal of zero emissions by 2050 and assembling a net-zero-emissions fleet of vehicles by 2030. In 2022, The Vatican joined the 1992 United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change and the 2015 Paris Agreement.

Vatican City will soon be 100 percent solar-powered, becoming the eighth country to achieve this milestone. Pope Francis stresses the ethical and social necessity to fight climate change so that the plan in the Vatican's new solar plant project underlines their global commitment to climate neutrality and sustainability.
